

## Tattoo Experience Tour 10 Day Tour

On this tour you will experience Scottish music at its best taking in the most popular historic sites in Scotland and enjoying benefits that not many other tourists will ever know about. This tour will include the Isle of Skye, Edinburgh Castle and Military Tattoo, Stirling Castle and more...

### Day 1

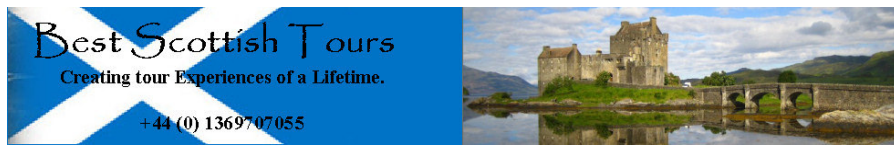
Our Driver will collect you from Edinburgh or Glasgow airport and start your Scottish experience by taking you to **Scotland's First National Park** on the bonnie banks of **Loch Lomond**. From here we will go to the town of **Dunoon** which is known as "**The Gateway to the Highlands**". Here you will be met at our chosen hotel and hear your first piece of Scottish music while being piped into your hotel on arrival. After a well earned rest you will have a delicious Scottish Dinner.

### Day 2

After a full Scottish breakfast we will travel to **Inverary**, headquarters of Clan Campbell and home to the Duke and Duchess of Argyll. Here we can take a tour of the castle and learn all the history surrounding Argyll. We will then travel to **Kilmartin Glen** to see the ancient Standing Stones before heading back to Dunoon in time for your evening meal.

### Day 3

After a hearty Scottish Breakfast, we will depart for the **Isle of Skye**. We take the Highland roads via Dalmeally and then on to **Glen Coe** where we will get to know a little more about the history surrounding the Highlands at the Glen Coe Visitor Centre. We then head for the **Eilean Donan Castle** probably one of Scotland's most photographed Castles. We will then make our way to our chosen hotel in time for dinner.



#### Day 4

Today after our Scottish Breakfast, we will be visiting the **Isle of Skye** for the first time. We will visit the capital of the Island - a town called **Portree**. Then follows a visit to the **Talisker Whiskey Distillery** (the only Distillery on Skye) for a Connoisseurs Tour (includes tasting and a little keepsake). Later we visit **Armadale Castle and Gardens**, the **Cuillin Mountains and Dunvegan Castle**. We then return to our Highland Hotel for our second evening in the Misty Isle.

#### Day 5

After Breakfast, we head for **Fort Augustus** at the foot of **Loch Ness**. Here you will be able to witness the beauty of Loch Ness and the engineering that joins the Loch to the sea at the **Caledonian Canal**. From here we will head to **Edradour Distillery** which is claimed to be the smallest distillery in Scotland which produces some of the finest single malt. Then we carry on into **Pitlochry** which wins the "Town in Bloom" each year before heading to our hotel for dinner and our overnight stay.

#### Day 6

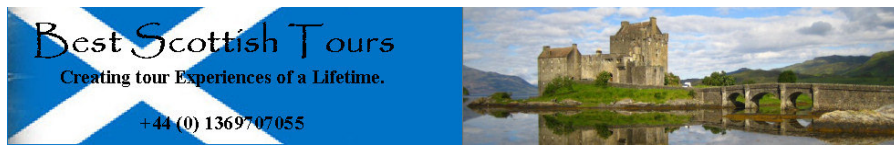
Today after breakfast, we make our way to **Stirling** where we will visit the **Wallace monument** which commemorates Scotland's greatest national hero, Sir William Wallace who defeated the English at the Battle of Stirling Bridge in the year 1297. We then visit Stirling Castle set high atop ancient rock and amazing history. Here we can arrange **lunch or high tea in the Stirling Castle Vaults** to make a memory to last a lifetime. After a wonderful day, we will head to our hotel for our dinner and our overnight stay.

#### Day 7

After a full Scottish Breakfast we have a leisurely morning as tonight is the night we will be going to the **Edinburgh Military Tattoo**. We will visit Famous **Falkirk Wheel** to see its amazing engineering before heading back to our hotel for a late lunch. After lunch we can relax in the hotel before heading for the train to take us into Edinburgh over the **Forth Road Bridge** in time to see the Military Tattoo. After the Tattoo we will return to our hotel by train.

#### Day 8

After a good night sleep we will head to **Bannockburn Heritage centre**. After this we will visit **Roslyn Chapel** made famous for its role in the Da Vinci Code. We then head back to our hotel in time for our evening meal.



## Day 9

This morning we have an early start as we will go to **Edinburgh Castle** for our **pre opening visit**. We will be escorted around the Castle prior to the opening hours to give you a personal experience of the Castle, followed by a lovely Scottish breakfast. We then visit the **National War museum** to hear more Scottish history. We can then head for the famous **Princess Street Gardens and the Royal Mile** for bit of Shopping before returning to our hotel in time for our evening meal.

## Day 10

After waking to another hearty Scottish Breakfast we will head for **Glasgow** to see the **Peoples Palace and Glasgow Green** before heading to the **National Piping Centre** to hear and learn all of this history about Scottish music. After this we will return you to Edinburgh or Glasgow for your final night stay in one of our chosen hotels before heading home.

## Day 11

All transfers will be arranged to take you from our chosen hotel to the airport in time for your flight home.
